- Facility Location:
8800 Corridor Road, Annapolis Junction, Maryland 20701
- Facility Description:
The Central Maryland Regional Transit Facility will house municipal transit vehicles in one central location for participating jurisdictions of the RTA (Regional Transportation Agency). Buses and transit vehicles will be serviced and maintained in one of seven maintenance bays. Refueling of the vehicles will also be done on-site. The project is seeking LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Silver Certification meeting the requirements of the US Green Building Council (USGBC). Some of the LEED components of the facility include: water use efficiency, energy optimization, recycled building materials and above average indoor environmental quality.
